

DOWNLOADING KINDLE EBOOKS ONTO THE IPAD

You will need a valid library card, wireless access, a free Amazon account, a free Apple ID, a free Kindle app, and your iPad.

1. Get your free Amazon login.

- Go to a computer and sign-up for a free Amazon ID at <http://www.amazon.com>.
- You should log into your Amazon account before proceeding (makes it easier).

2. Download the Kindle app on your iPad (you only need to do this once)

- Go to your Apple App Store and search for the Kindle app.
- Download the app. You will need your Apple ID.

Note: You do NOT need Overdrive Media Console to read Kindle books.

3. Log into your Live-brary.com account

- Log into the South Huntington PL website at <http://www.shpl.info> from your iPad.
- Tap on the blue Downloads box on the left-hand side of the screen.
- Tap on Free Downloads under Services on the left-hand side of the screen.
- Tap on the Overdrive option for downloading.
- Tap on Login on the right.
- Select South Huntington Public Library from the library scroll box.
- Enter your Barcode or Username. Tap on Login.
- You are now logged into your account.

4. Searching for a Kindle Title

There are VARIOUS ways to search for available Kindle books. Here is one way:

- Tap on the SEARCH option (with the magnifying glass).
- An Advanced option will appear on the right-hand side. Tap on it.
- Scroll down to Format. The default should be Kindle. Leave that as is.
- Scroll to the bottom and tap on the Available Now option, and then tap on Search.
- The result will be **all** the Kindle books that are currently available (more than 16,000!)
- **IMPORTANT NOTE:** If you see Kindle devices via USB only then you may **not** download that title onto your iPad. It is a publisher restriction.

5. Checkout!

- Find an available book and tap on Add to My Cart that is opposite the Kindle Book option.
- Tap on Proceed to Checkout.
- If you haven't already entered your library and barcode you will be prompted to.
- Tap on Confirm check out.
- Tap on Get for Kindle.

6. Amazon!

- At this point your iPad will automatically switch to Amazon.com.
- On the right you should see a big green box. Select where you would like the book to be delivered (your iPad), and then click on Get Library Book.

7. Read!

- Go to your Kindle app on your iPad and your book should be waiting for you in the Books and All Items directories. You can read from either directory.
