The mural is made possible through funds from the Statewide Community Regrant Program, which is administered by The Huntington Arts Council with support from the New York State Council on the Arts, the Governor, and the New York State Legislature.

The Statewide Community Regrant site for The New York State Council on the Arts manages the distribution of grants to support arts and cultural programming in Nassau and Suffolk counties. In 2024, it awarded 87 grants to individual artists and organizations across various disciplines, including visual arts and theater. Additionally, through its Community Impact Micro Grant program, the organization provides small grants every two months to further support and enhance local arts initiatives.
