

Coffee Filter Art

Learn how to create beautiful artwork with a watercolor tie dye look using only coffee filters, markers, and water! This easy art project is fun for the whole family.

Materials Needed

Coffee filters

Any water based markers such as Crayola or Mr. Sketch (washable markers work too)

Spray bottle of water or small cup of water

Plastic tablecloth or plastic drop cloth to protect table from water

Paper towels for messes

Tips

After coloring on the dry coffee filter make sure to spray enough water to soak the filter in order to get the diffusion effect.

You can leave a little bit of white space if you like or fill the whole filter with color.

Things to do with your dry coffee filter art masterpieces

Hang in windows; they look cool with the light filtering through.

Tape several together and make a chain to hang on a wall or across a doorway.

Cut up and use for arts and crafts projects.

Bunch several together and make into a flower.
