Your grown-up should have received an email message containing instructions for joining our **Zoom** meeting. Please join the meeting at 4 p.m. (Your grown-up may need to download the Zoom app to your device before the meeting.)

The best way to participate in our Bowling Tournament is to join Zoom via a device that can be easily moved around (iPad, smartphone, or laptop). You can still participate using a desktop computer—just be sure you choose bowling supplies can be easily set up on a table or desk.

To participate in our first-ever Online Bowling Tournament, you will need to gather six "pins" and one "bowling ball." You should be able to find these things around your house. You can even mix and match! Here are some suggestions:



PINS: You will need 6 items that are lightweight, easy to knock down and easy to set up. You can use empty plastic jars or metal cans, empty water bottles, action figures or dolls, paper tubes, or small toys, such as Lego figures.



BOWLING BALL: You will need 1 bowling ball. This can be a tennis ball or baseball, a wiffle ball, a marble, a golf ball, a bouncy ball, or a piece of crunched-up aluminum foil. Be sure the ball you choose is not bigger than your pins!
